22—No Second Prize in case of less than Four Entries, and no Third Prize in case of less than Five. Unless in the opinion of the Judges there is exceptional merit shown.

23—The Committee may, after closing of Entries, cancel any Class, should, however, any Class be cancelled, notice will be given to entrants, and Entry Fees returned.

24—No exhibit to be allowed to be removed before 2.30 from Show Ground. Any Prize-winner leaving Show Ground before the hour specified shall forfeit any prizes awarded. This Rule will be strictly enforced.

25—All Prize-winners in Classes for Horses from three years old upwards (brood mares excepted) to be subject to V.S. examination. If a horse is rejected for unsoundness, then the next in order of merit to be eligible for prize.

26—Any objection to a Horse on the grounds of Unsoundness must be lodged in writing with the Secretary before four o'clock on day of Show, together with a sum of £2, which will be forfeited to Funds of Show if in the opinion of V.S. appointed by Committee the objection is not sustained.

27—Horses will be measured in shoes in which they come, and no objection on the grounds of height will be received after four o'clock on day of Show.

28—Any objection to Judges' Awards, other than on unsoundness, must be lodged, in writing, with the Secretary before four o'clock on day of Show, together with a fee of 10s., which will be forfeited if objection is regarded by the Committee as frivolous. Such objection must state the grounds for same.

29—Any objection to Entry must be lodged in writing within Ten Days from Date of Show. Otherwise it will not be entertained. All objections must be accompanied by a fee of 10s., which will be forfeited if objection is regarded by Committee as frivolous.

30—The Committee will not be responsible for any loss or accident to any Exhibit, nor entertain any claim whatever for Loss or Damage to any Exhibit while in the Show, in transit to or from the Show, which are only admitted at Owner's Risk. The Committee shall not be responsible for any claim for Compensation arising out of holding or connection with the Show. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any Exhibitor or other person attending the Show.

31—Any Animal suffering from any contagious disease must be immediately removed if certified by V.S. of the Show.

32—Exhibitors' Servants who do not conform to Rules and Conditions of Show will be expelled by Committee.

33—Any person to whom premium has been awarded may be requested to satisfy the Committee, by declaration or otherwise, by such proof as the Committee may require, as to correctness of Entry, etc., and upon refusal such Prize will be withheld.

34—Special Prizes, Challenge Cups, etc., until these are finally won, the person to whom they are awarded must give security to the Committee that such Prize will be delivered up to the Secretary in as good condition as it was received on or before the 15th July, 1933.

35—Seven Members of Committee to form a quorum.
