CLASS 29—Best Registered Dairy Cow, in milk or in calf, the property of members of Cow Testing Associations. Exhibitors must state on the entry form the following particulars, otherwise the exhibit will be disqualified: 1. Name, colour, date of birth, and number of the cow in the Department's Register. 2. Date of last calving. 3. (a) Yield of milk on which the cow was accepted for registration; (b) Number of weeks in milking period; (c) Statement in respect of butter-fat; (d) Age of cow at commencement of milking period. 4. (a) Highest recorded subsequent yield, particulars of which have been accepted for entry in the Department's Register, and statement in respect of butter-fat, if available; (b) Number of weeks in subsequent milking period; (c) Age of cow at commencement of this period. To encourage a dual purpose animal of Shorthorn type, Judges, besides giving credit for the milking properties, will give due consideration to the size, constitution, symmetry and quality of the animals, and for this purpose the following scale of points will be used by the Judges: (a) **Milk Record**—1 point for each 100 lbs. of milk. No points to be allowed for milk yield after the 45th week in the milking period. (b) **Butter-fat**—fifteen points for every one per cent of fat shown on the average of the percentages of butter-fat, fractions of percentage of fat being allowed for proportionately. (c) **Shape and formation of udder and teats**—maximum 50 points. (d) **Size, symmetry, and general appearance of frame**—maximum 150 points. (In the case of a cow which qualified for registration on the period following her first calving, provided such calving occurred before the first week of the year of 3½ years, no objection would be made
