CLASS 15—Best Pure-bred Registered Dairy Shorthorn Bull, any age. Exhibitors must state on the entry form the following particulars, otherwise the exhibit will be disqualified: 1. Name, colour and date of birth of bull. 2. Name of sire and number in Herd Book or in Department's Register. 3. (a) Name of dam and number in Department's Register; (b) Yield of milk on which Cow was accepted for Registration; (c) Number of weeks in milking period; (d) Statement in respect of butter-fat; (e) Age of cow at commencement of milking period. 4. (a) Highest recorded subsequent yield of dam, particulars of which have been accepted for entry in the Department's Register, and statement in respect of butter-fat, if available; (b) Number of weeks in subsequent milking period. 5. If sire is a registered dairy bull, particulars of its dam should be given as at (3) and (4) above. Bulls entered in this class must have been accepted by the Department for entry in their Register as Registered Dairy Bulls. N.B.—Prizes in this class shall not be paid until the correctness of the particulars published shall have been confirmed by the Department. First prize, £5, presented by Rev. W. H. A. Truett, 2nd, £2; 3rd, £1.
